Commonly called "12-mile road"

Materials Accepted: Slash and natural

woody debris only – no trash!

Each load will be evaluated - prior to unloading



The US Forest Service, San Carlos Ranger District, has graciously offered this site again this year for the collection day and will burn the piles next winter. To help protect your national forest, these **STRICT RULES MUST BE ADHERED TO**:

- ➤ Woody debris from your <u>area</u> property only
- > Limbs & branches from firs, pines, oak & brush
- ➤ NO: Lumber, weeds, grass, sawdust, stumps, wood chips or trash of any kind!
- Please do not bring ground litter such as pine needles
- ➤ NO COMMERCIAL OPERATORS
